Survey of community mental health services 2010

To improve the quality of services that the NHS delivers, it is important to understand what service users think about their care and treatment. One way of doing this is by asking people who have recently used their local health services to tell us about their experiences.

The 2010 survey of community mental health services involved 66 NHS trusts in England (including combined mental health and social care trusts, Foundation Trusts and primary care trusts that provide mental health services). We received responses from more than 17,000 service users, a response rate of 32%. Service users aged 16 and over were eligible for the survey if they were seen at the trust between 1 July 2009 and 30 September 2009 and had received specialist care or treatment for a mental health condition.

Surveys of people using community mental health services have previously been carried out annually between 2004 and 2008. In 2008 and in previous years the survey was of service users receiving *standardqor standardqor sta*

set out in *Refocusing the Care Programme Approach*¹, the sampling methodology for the survey was revised to include both service users who have their care co-ordinated under the CPA and other service users in contact with secondary mental health services. The content of the questionnaire was also updated to reflect the changes in the national policy. As a result of these various changes, the results from the 2010 community survey are not comparable with surveys carried out between 2004-2008. The survey of community mental health services 2010 is part of a wider programme of NHS patient surveys, which covers a range of topics including inpatient services, outpatient services and ambulance services. Interpreting the tables

Two sets of tables are provided. The full national results tables present the overall percentages based on all respondents.² The second set of tables provides results separately for those on CPA and those not on CPA

The tables show all specific responses to a question. Responses such as % dond know+or % and remember+are not shown and have been excluded from the analysis, as these do not help evaluate performance.

Filter questions

Not all of the questions in the survey were to be answered by everybody. Some questions are not applicable to everyone: for example, if a respondent had not taken any prescribed

Some trusts have a higher response rate than others and would therefore have a greater influence over the England (national) average. To correct this we apply a <u>aveightqto</u> the data. As a result of applying this weight, the responses from each trust have an equal influence over the England average, regardless of differences in response rates between trusts.

medications for their mental health condition at Q9 then they would be instructed to skip the questions about medication and go to Q17.

Multiple Response Questions

The survey included one question with a response option to % ick all that apply+(Q53). Where this is the case we have presented percentages for each option, out of all those eligible to answer that question (some respondents may have ticked more than one category). This means that the results add up to over 100%.
